

LSCB Training Allocations Policy

The Local Safeguarding Children Board agreed to a new model of Level 3 Safeguarding Training. Level three courses are targeted at members of the workforce who have particular responsibilities for undertaking child protection enquiries and who work with complex cases e.g. professionals from Children's Social Care, Police, Health and Education. Training at this level is for staff who hold professional or organisational authority and a substantial degree of personal responsibility and autonomy to act on child welfare concerns.



Member agencies of the LSCB have paid a contribution, in accordance with the pooled budget arrangements, towards the development and delivery of the Level 3 Working Together to Safeguard Children and Young People Training sessions.

Spaces on this training are therefore allocated in accordance with the % contribution from each agency.

This is set out as follows:

Southampton City Council (People Directorate) x 13 places:

- 2 x Schools staff
- 5 x Children and Families staff
- 1 x Adults Safeguarding staff
- 1 x Housing Services Staff
- 2 x Early Years staff
- 2 x Early Help Staff

Clinical Commissioning Group x 6 places:

- 1 x SCAS
- 1 x GP
- 1 x Solent NHS
- 1 x University Hospital Southampton NHS Foundation Trust
- 1 x Southern Health
- 1 x Spare

Hampshire Constabulary x 2 places

National Probation Service/Community Rehabilitation Company x 1 place

CAFCASS x 1 place

Voluntary Sector x 2 places
